Principle:

De dwa da dehs nye>s Aboriginal Health Centre (DAHAC) is committed to protecting the privacy, confidentiality, and security of all personal health information that has been entrusted to us. DAHAC provides this protection, in part, by complying with Ontario's *Personal Health Information Protection Act*, enacted on November 1, 2004. The Personal Health Information Protection Act establishes rules concerning the collection, use and disclosure of personal health information (PHI).

Policy:

The Privacy Officer(s) is appointed by the Chief Executive Officer and is delegated to act on behalf of the Chief Executive Officer with respect to the oversight and compliance of privacy at De dwa da dehs nye>s Aboriginal Health Centre.

Procedure:

The Chief Executive Officer(s) will appoint The Privacy Officer (CPO). The Privacy Officer(s) will perform CPO duties as outlined in the job description. (Please refer Privacy Officer job description).

Amendment:

This policy may only be amended by the Chief Executive Officer.
