INTRODUCTION:

The Concurrent Disorders Mental Wellness Case Manager (CDMW) promotes the mental health and well being of Adult clients of DAHAC. The CDMW worker conducts individual counselling services for clients. This role is responsible for, developing, implementing and coordinating support services. This role provides mental health counselling, assessment, treatment and education to adults as well as multi-modality treatment using clinical, alternative complimentary and integrative energy health practices.

Required Knowledge, Skills and Ability

- Knowledge and ability to integrate wholistic, strength and evidence based practice into the planning and evaluation of client and program intervention from a trauma informed lens
- Knowledge of Indigenous cultures, customs and traditions.

- Knowledge of mental health and addictions counselling models, techniques, modalities and approaches.
- Knowledge of tools, systems and databases used in client services delivery and case management.

- Possess excellent time management, organization, and communication skills
